## Getting started with SaxoMobileTrader on your BlackBerry®

1. On the Internet browser on your mobile phone, enter [www.saxomobiletrader.com](http://www.saxomobiletrader.com) on your browser.
2. Login with your **SaxoID** and **Password**.

### 1. Selecting your instrument

- 1.1 Choose **Market Prices** from the main menu
- 1.2 Choose your desired instrument from the list. If it is not available, scroll down, type in the name of instrument such as **Gold** or **Vodafone** in the blank and press **Search**.
- 1.3 Alternatively, scroll further and choose **MORE**.

### 2. Executing Trade


- 2.1 Click on **SELL** or **BUY** respectively on the current trading window to place your trade once you have selected your instrument under **Markets Prices**.
- 2.2 Select **Continue** once you have accessed the details of your trades.
- 2.3 Press **YES** to execute your trade.



Related orders can also be added and an FX Spot trade can be changed to a Forward Outright order if you wish.

### 3. Managing your Open Positions

- 3.1 Choose **Open Positions** from the main menu and you will see a complete overview of your positions.
- 3.2 Click on the "+" icon to the left of the instrument and you will be able to modify your position.
- 3.3 Click on the underlined ID if you would like to add any related orders to the specific position.
- 3.4 Click on the "x" icon to close a position at the current market price.



#### Useful definitions:

**L/S:** This indicates whether your position is long or short

**Amount:** This shows the nominal value of your position. K= thousand, M= million

**P/L:** Shows the total Profit or Loss for the given instrument, at current mid market price

## 4. Managing Open Orders

- 4.1 Choose **Open Orders** from the Main Menu.
- 4.2 Use this section to place new or related orders. The latter are marked as grey background.
- 4.3 Click on the underlined instrument symbol of the order to manage orders related at this specific position.  
(see example GSEN:xnas)
- 4.4 Click on "x" to cancel orders or related orders.




### Useful definitions:

**Place Order:** Use this to create new order on any instrument of your choice.

**Price:** This shows you at which price your order is set to be executed.

## 5. Checking your Account Summary

- 5.1 Choose "Account Status" from the main Menu.
- 5.2 The **Cash and Positions Summary** gives you the key figures concerning the value of your account. This includes unrealized profit/loss, transactions not yet booked and cost to close.
- 5.3 Scroll down to see the **Margin Summary** that gives you overview information concerning your margin exposure in the market.
- 5.4 Click on **Refresh** button at the bottom of this page to update the information.



## 6. Using Charts

- 6.1 Choose **Chart** from the Main Menu.
- 6.2 Select your instrument from the drop down menu or click **More** to browse all instruments.
- 6.3 Scroll down and click **Chart Settings** to customize your chart.



Under Chart Settings you can set your chart view by selecting your preferred period and chart type (Line, OHLC, HLC or Candlestick). You can also change the chart size to fit the screen on your iPod. To automatically pick up the optimal size of your device, select the "Auto" setting.
